

This year, the Colony Club will again be involved in remembering Veterans by participating in the Wreaths Across America project. This organization honors fallen veterans by the placement of a living wreath on veteran's graves at over 2100 locations in all 50 states. The fresh evergreen wreath is traditionally a symbol of Honor. This year the Remembrance Day will be on Saturday, December 16th at 12 noon.

#### Our participation will be two-fold:

1-We will be collecting contributions from our club members at both the October and November general membership meetings. Please feel free to ask family and friends if they would like to contribute. We accept cash or checks made out to the Colony Club of Ocean City. For every 2 wreaths we purchase, a 3rd will be donated by Wreaths Across America. The wreaths are \$17 each. As we remember and honor many local fallen veterans, we hope all Colony Club members will be able to contribute as generously as in past years.

2- We are also planning to participate in the actual wreath laying at Cape May County Veterans Cemetery in Cape May Court House, on December 16th. We will attend the short ceremony, get our instructions, and lay the wreaths. Everyone is welcome to participate and we will be getting more information out as we get closer to the event.
